This event will bring together over 200 researchers, academics, professionals, and students from around the world to analyze the geographies of peace and war, with a special focus on territorial conflicts, environmental impacts, and peacebuilding.

Santa Marta, the oldest city on the South American Caribbean coast, celebrates its 500th anniversary in 2025. Surrounded by the Caribbean Sea and the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta, this historic city embodies resilience, conflict, and reconciliation.

The conference will feature keynote speakers, academic discussions, field activities, and intercultural exchanges, fostering a multidisciplinary dialogue on geography, conflict, and reconciliation.
